




- Wear a bicycle helmet.
- Ride with the traffic flow.
- Ride in a straight line.
- Ride to the right

(Unless you are turning left, passing another bicycle or vehicle, or avoiding hazards.)

- Stop at stop signs and red lights.
- Use a light, reflectors and reflective clothing at night.
- Wear bright clothing during the daytime.
- Keep a safe distance from parked cars.
- Use proper hand signals when turning, stopping or changing lanes.
- Use extra caution when it is raining, and allow extra time to stop.
- Cross railroad tracks at a right angle.
- 12. Walk your bike when using a crosswalk.
- Do not wear headphones on both ears while riding.
- Keep your bike properly maintained so it is safe.
- 15. Do not drink and ride.
- Be alert for road hazards.
- Watch for cars at cross streets and driveways.
- Obey all traffic signals.
- 19. Be aware of parked cars and watch for Car doors that may open.
- 20. Give pedestrians the right of way.

BREAK THE ROAD CODE

- Always wear a H E L M E T when riding a bike.
- 2. O R D I N A R Y kids can be E X T R A ordinary heroes!
- 3. The U L T I M A T E adventure is saving lives!
- Report H I D D E N stop signs to an A D U L T right away.
- 5. $\frac{S}{4} = \frac{T}{23} = \frac{O}{20} = \frac{P}{11}$ signs are red with white letters.
- Look B O T H ways before C R O S S I N G the street.
- 7. Never C H A S E a ball into the street. Always stop and L O O K first.
- Always wear your S E A T B E L T snugly when riding in a car.
- 9. When $\frac{R}{26}$ $\frac{I}{6}$ $\frac{D}{22}$ $\frac{I}{6}$ $\frac{N}{8}$ $\frac{G}{2}$ your bike in a street, always ride the $\frac{S}{4}$ $\frac{A}{16}$ $\frac{M}{19}$ $\frac{E}{10}$ direction that cars go.
- 10. When walking along a street that has no <u>S I D E W A L K S</u>, always walk <u>F A C I N G traffic.</u>
